Across China, millions of Christians gather in homes, small fellowships, and underground churches. Many meet quietly, not by preference, but because faithfulness to Christ places them under pressure.

Some churches face raids, detentions, and closures. Others face a different danger: isolation, false teaching, and groups that prey on believers with little training or support.

Yet the gospel continues to spread. The church in China needs not only our sympathy, but our prayers and practical support.



How to Pray

1. For persecuted churches

Pray for congregations like Early Rain and Zion Church—for endurance, courage, and faithfulness under pressure.

2. For pastors and leaders

Ask Christ to raise up and preserve wise, godly shepherds, even where training is difficult.

3. For protection from false teaching

Pray for believers who are isolated or newly converted, that they would not be led astray by controlling or deceptive groups.

4. For sound teaching to spread

Ask God to provide Scripture-saturated, confessional resources to strengthen churches for long-term faithfulness.
